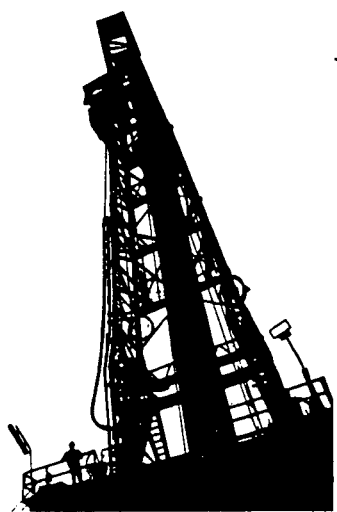


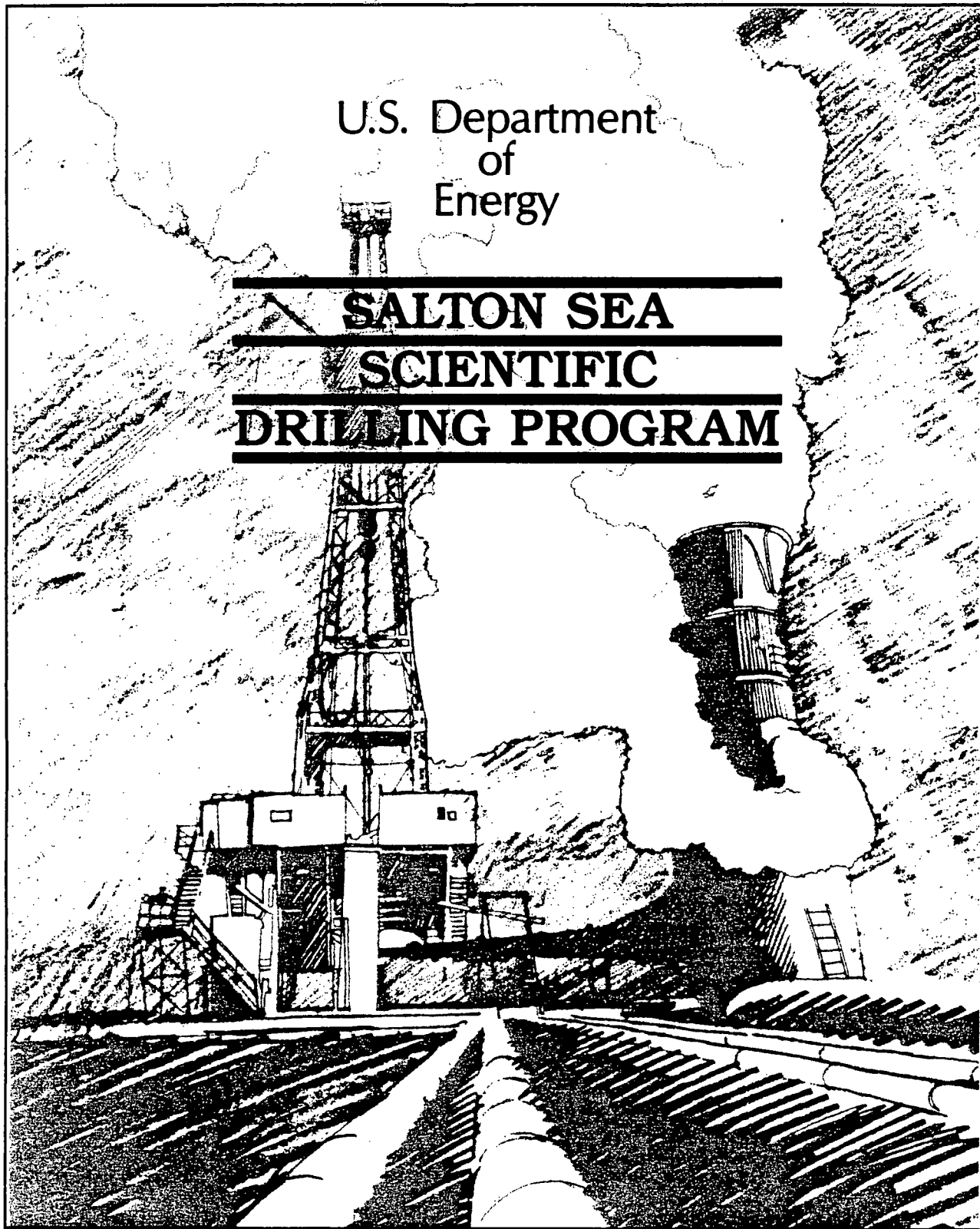

VISITOR SAFETY PROCEDURES

Safety is everyone's responsibility. Beyond the use of common sense, the following basic health and safety rules must be observed by visitors at this site.

1. Visitors will be assigned to an on-site sponsor who will be responsible for familiarizing them with safety rules and procedures. The sponsor will provide a hard hat and other safety equipment, as required.
2. Visitors must wear ID that identifies them by name and affiliation. Ideally, this will be shown on the hard hat.
3. Visitors who will be working at the site will also be given instructions regarding specific job hazards to which they may be exposed.
4. Hard hats must be worn all times, except within buildings.
5. Steel-toed safety shoes or boots must be worn when working on and near the rig and other operating equipment.
6. Trousers (not shorts) and shirts must be worn in work areas at all times.
7. Safety glasses or a face shield must be worn in certain areas of the site or when conducting certain operations that have a high potential for eye damage.
8. An appropriate type of gloves must be worn when working in an area where there is a potential for burns, cuts, etc.
9. No one will be permitted on the rig floor nor in the active work areas immediately around the drilling rig without the permission of the Drilling Supervisor *and* the Rig Supervisor (Tool Pusher). All persons in this area must follow safety instructions of the Rig Supervisor.
10. Potentially dangerous machinery will be operated only by qualified personnel.
11. Drugs, alcohol, and firearms are not permitted on the site. No one will be permitted into high risk working areas if they are clearly under the influence of drugs or alcohol and, in the judgment of the Site Manager, could constitute a safety hazard to themselves or others.
12. Contractor and government vehicles will be driven only by licensed and authorized persons. Seat belts must be worn at all times. California and local laws must be obeyed. Vehicles will be driven for official use only.
