

Amax Exploration, Inc., has submitted a Unit Plan of Exploration in accordance with 30 CFR 270.34 to drill up to twenty-three (23) 8000-foot (2462 meters) geothermal exploratory wells on Federal Leases N-31417, N-31418. N-31419, N-31420, N-31421, N-31422, and N-31423 in the Alum Unit, Esmeralda County, Nevada. A copy of the Unit Plan of Exploration is available from the Office of the Deputy Conservation Manager for Geothermal, or the Office of the Reno District Geothermal Supervisor.

A Categorical Exclusion Review (CER #191-82) will be prepared by the Office of the Deputy Conservation Manager for Geothermal for the proposed action. A field inspection is not considered necessary at this time. You are encouraged to visit the site at your own convenience. This letter is submitted as an addendum to the above referenced report and may be cited as authority for the additions and changes listed below.

The planned well location as shown on Exhibit "A" were based upon office picks. When the holes were flagged hole 32-36 TlN R38E had to be moved to a 41-36 TlN R38E location. Three copies of a Sundry Notice for the proposed changes are enclosed.

AMAX would like to add one hole, a 56-29 TlN R38 1/2E location, to the POE. Three copies of the Geothermal Drilling Permit are enclosed.

AMAX requests that the enclosed pages 3-1, and 3-2 be added to the section of the POE titled DETAILS OF WORK. The new pages outline an integrated exploration program of geological, geochemical and geophysical studies and a phased exploration drilling program including shallow
