Basaltic cones, craters, or flows from which lava flows issued or were formed by lava flowing into the sea, or pit craters

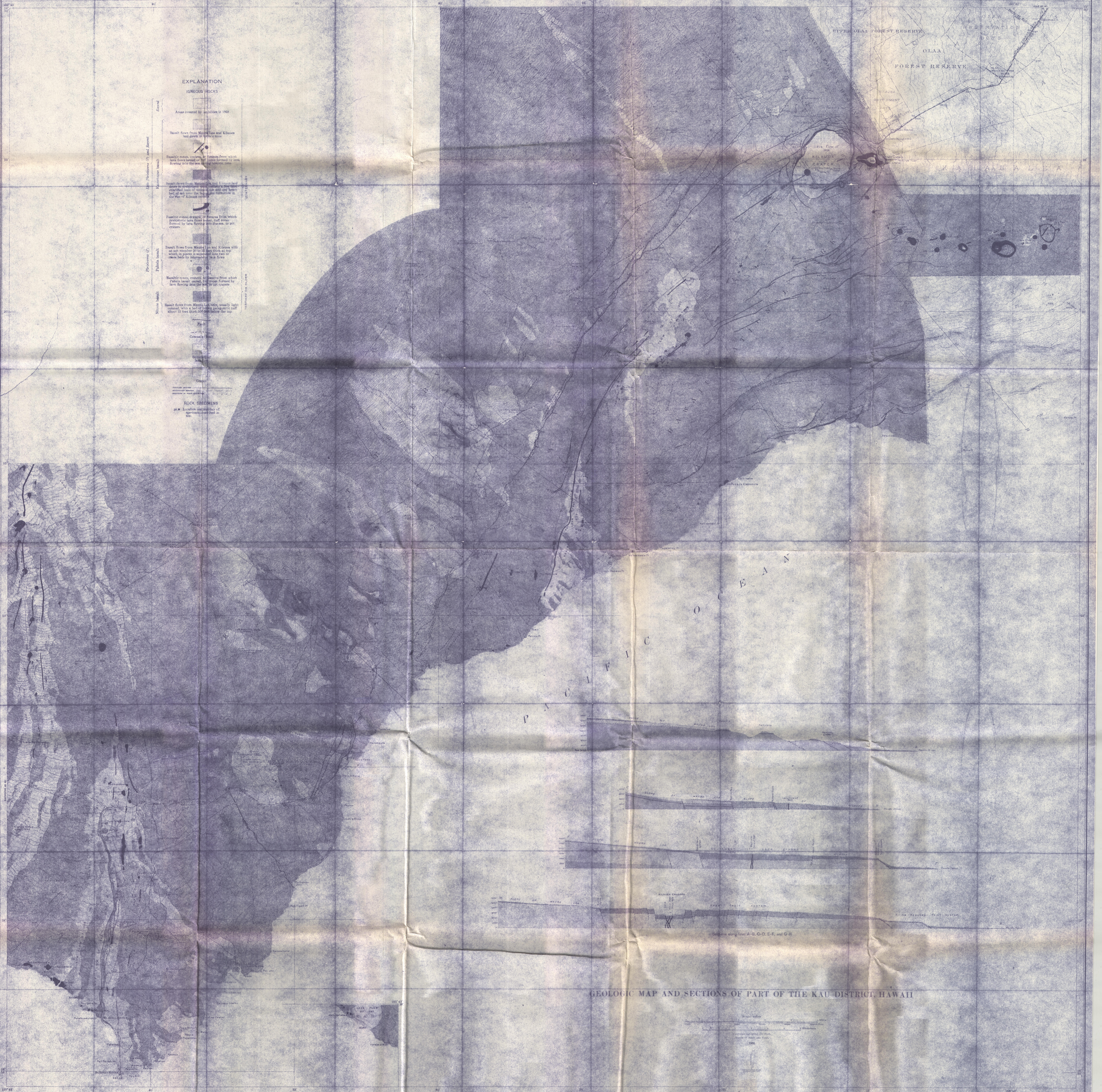
