Dear Hank:

The Petroleum Information Corporation (PI) data we have discussed was released to us as a DOE contractor through an agreement made between PI and the USGS.

This agreement states that:

- 1. Purchased data may be used only for Government or Government-contracted studies.
- 2. No data may be released in computer-processable form.
- 3. In no case may the government or its contractors release a complete well history in any form.
- 4. Data may be used in Government or Government-contracted studies, and the results of statistical analyses or syntheses, such as maps, sections, charts and tables, may be published.

State agencies can be covered under this agreement. To receive the Wyoming portion of the PI data, it is necessary that you return to us the attached form identifying your agency and valid signatories. We will make copies and proper distribution of these. Once this is done, we are free to send you the PI data we now have on Wyoming.

Costs for the complete Wyoming subfile as a computer printout is \$55.00. The cost to supply the microfiche of the same file is \$10.00. The total package amounts to 961 pages which appear on 6 microfiche sheets.
