Pursuant to our conversation on August 30, 1979, this letter is written to document AMAX Exploration Inc.'s drilling activities at the Jemez Project in New Mexico. AMAX Exploration Inc. personnel informed Mr. Ellis Hammett of the U.S. Geological Survey on July 30, 1979 that we would begin drilling operations during the first week in August. Mr. Hammett executed a renewal of AMAX Exploration Inc.'s Permit AGS-90-NM30803 on August 6, 1979. Copies of this agreement were forwarded to you and Mr. Reid Stone on August 7, 1979.
