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The thermal logging went fine. I finished up Saturday afternoon. The only real hold-up was the inability of the metal detector and me in finding the down drill holes + PVC. I found + logged all of them, some just took longer than others. Number 22 was the one I couldn't log. The probe went down 10 meters and hit mud - I don't think there was any water in the first 10 meters - I'm not sure about the rest of the PVC. I poured about 2 gallons of water in the hole then tried to get the probe down again but no luck. So there's no log on 22. All the others went fine. Numbers 24, 28, and 27 had the most exceptional gradients.

All in all, things went well. I hated leaving myself from Austin - got in Elko Sunday evening. Talk to you soon —
