> Re: Geothermal Drilling Permits for Wells Nos. 51-29, and 31-32 (Alum Unit, Esmeralda County, Nevada) and Well No. 26-8 (McCoy Unit, Churchill County, Nevada)

Dear Mr. Heiller:

As I indicated to you in our phone conversation of January 4, 1983, AMAX has completed Well No. 81-7 at the Tuscarora Unit and will commence drilling Well No. 26-8 at the McCoy Unit on approximately January 10, 1983. Upon completion of the McCoy well, the drilling rig will be moved to the Alum Unit to commence drilling Wells Nos. 51-29 and 31-32.

In conjunction with AMAX's drilling plans, there are several matters to be resolved:

- Alum Unit Well No. 51-29. On December 8, 1982, AMAX submitted to you a Geothermal Drilling Permit for this well. Enclosed in triplicate is a plat showing the location of the hole. This should complete the file on this well.
- 2. Alum Unit Well No. 31-32. Enclosed in triplicate is a plat showing the location of Well No. 31-32. On May 28, 1981, AMAX submitted a Geothermal Drilling Permit for this well to your office. The Geothermal Drilling Permit has not yet been approved.
- 3. <u>McCoy Unit Well No. 26-8</u>. On December 7, 1982, AMAX submitted to you a revised Geothermal Drilling Permit for Well No. 26-8 with accompanying plats. The approved Geothermal Drilling Permit has not yet been received in our office.

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As AMAX intends to commence drilling on the subject wells shortly, we would appreciate if you could expedite the processing of the Geothermal Drilling Permits for these wells.
