

On January 13, 1981 I led a site inspection tour of eight sites for proposed intermediate depth temperature observation holes in the McCoy, Nevada project area. In attendance were Doug Koza, from the USGS and Dan Jacquet and Margret Shively with the BLM. Due to the excessive costs involved (approximately \$1500/site), only six sites have been surveyed.

All sixteen proposed drill holes from the November 1980 PPO have been staked and a Cultural Research Inventory by Archeological - Environmental Resources Corp. has been completed. In order to prevent unnecessary expenditures, the ten unsurveyed holes should be held in a suspended status and if the need arises they may be surveyed and field inspected at that time.
