After the drill hole is completed and the drill stem removed from the hole, a 3/4 inch PVC pipe which has been capped on the bottom, is inserted into the hole. The pipe is filled with water and capped. The area around the intruded pipe is then backfilled with drill cuttings.

ABANDONMENT PROCEDURE

The PVC pipe is cut off below ground level. The upper 3 m (10 feet) is filled with cement. Any remaining depression is filled with soil and is raked to restore the site to its original appearance and contour. The affected area is seeded if required. All drilling related refuse is removed and disposed of properly.

Hole No. 903-3 encountered water at 51 m. Surface pipe was set and cemented to contain artesian flow. Surface casing now stands approximately 6 to 8 inches above the ground.

Hole No. 903-12 was not drilled.
