
Dear Mr. Moroz:

advise that such operations were completed (date) May 1, 1981, on the lands described in the above identified notice.


METHOD OF COMPLETION

After Hole Nos. 1030-41 and 1030-45 were completed and the drill stem removed from the holes, a 3/4" PVC pipe, which had been capped on the bottom, was inserted into the holes. The pipe was filled with water and capped. The area around the intruded pipe was then backfilled with drill cuttings.

ABANDONMENT PROCEDURE

The PVC pipe was cut off below ground level. The upper 3m (10 feet) was filled with cement. Any remaining depression was filled with soil and raked to restore the site to its original appearance and contour. All drilling-related refuse was removed and disposed of properly.
