



8 - 20	Alternating buff to gray tuffaceous siltstone and claystone of the Chalk Butte formation.
20 - 32	Buff to yellow brown tuffaceous sandstone and conglomerate sandstone of the Chalk Butte formation. The hole was dry to the total depth.


