This will confirm my telephone call of February 17, 1975, accepting your bid of \$50/hr plus mud and bits for the drilling of 90 temperature gradient holes to a depth of 50 meters in 5 different areas of eastern Oregon. The drilling will be done with a Failing 1250 equipped with a 3 X 4 mud pump, a 450 ft³ compressor set for both high and low pressure work, and a 1800 gal water tanker as outlined in our telephone conversations of February 11 and 12.
