I got your email address from Jeff Hulen, I'm working with UNAVCO, Inc which is a NSF funded nonprofit group. We are going to install eight borehole strainmeter/seismic sites in the medicine lake/ mt. Shasta area. Jeff said you have core samples from this region. We would like to look at any samples from the medicine lake region. The strainmeters are installed into drilled holes at depths between 500-800 ft and require a 10-15 ft section of compotent unfractured rock (always a problem). Looking at core samples may help us determine the best locations for these sites. I am scheduled to go to Salt Lake City on Jan 27 to meet with Dennis Neilson (DOSEC) and I was hoping to possible schedule a time and date around the 27th to visit your facility???
