Depth (m)	Description
0 - 33	<u>Gravel-Silt</u> - Angular gravels of andesite, latite, and minor rhyolite (2-10 cm. in diameter). Considerable L.C. in this interval.
33 - 45	<u>Clay-Gravel</u> - Angular gravels as above, except light-gray andesite gravels increasing with depth.
45 - 67	<u>Andesite-Clay</u> - Medium-gray porphyritic andesite. Phenos of white plag (0.5-2.0 mm) altered to kaolinite, set in aphanitic g.m. 30-50% of cuttings gray, moist clay.
67 - 90	<u>Andesite</u> - Medium-gray, crystals of white plag altered to kaolinite set in aphanitic g.m. 1-2% hb crystals. 5-10% pyrite both disseminated in small crystals and in masses filling fractures. Some FeO ₂ staining along tight fractures.
90 - 320	<u>Andesite</u> - As above, but less altered, harder. 10-35% white quartz veining.
