0 - 5	<u>Qal</u> - yellow-brown silt with frags of red to gray latite porphyry.
5 - 7	<u>Latite</u> - gray aphanitic
7 - 14	<u>Latite</u> - gray to red prophyritic.
14 - 32	<u>Latite</u> - gray XL-bearing to aphanitic
32 - 40	<u>Latite</u> - as above, but more reddish.
40 - 44	<u>Latite</u> - red oxidized and altered.
44 - 53	<u>Latite</u> - reddish-gray, XL-bearing, Large feldspar XLS. ($K=6.5-7.0$)
53 - 67	<u>Obsidian</u> - Dark gray, highly fractured, partly devitrified, devitrification increases with depth. 85% at 220'
