0 - 10	<u>Qal</u> - silt and sand with minor cobbles of BSLT.
10 - 14	<u>Tuff</u> - gray-green, poorly indurated. XLS of feldspar altered to clay, 20% XL
14 - 23	<u>Basalt</u> - Dark gray aphanitic to slightly porp. Moderate chlorite alteration.
23 - 30	<u>Basalt</u> - Broken with cinders and yellow clay
30 - 46	<u>Basalt</u> - as above, but less cinder and zones of brown tuff (K=4.0)
46 - 50	<u>Basalt</u> - as above, but red oxidized.
50 - 63	<u>Basalt</u> - as 97-150
63 - 67	<u>Basalt</u> - as 150-.65
