<u>Depth (M)</u>	<u>Description</u>
0 - 3	Soil, light-buff, fine-grained, mostly eolian sands with some lag gravels.
3 - 93	Sand, gravel and boulders of the valley fill - part of alluvial fan on the north side of the Black Mountains. The dominant rock type found in the gravels and boulders is reddish-gray to reddish-brown rhyodacite flows, ash flows, and crystal tuffs.
