Depth (m)	DESCRIPTION
0 - 14	<u>Tuff</u> - Red, altered mostly to clay with small zones of silica (K=4.0)
14 - 21	<u>Tuff</u> - Red, mostly silicified with 8-10% feldspar. (K=6.0)
21 - 26	<u>Tuff</u> - Red, poorly indurated, becoming more yellow with depth.
26 - 37	<u>Tuff</u> - Medium gray, moist, completely altered to clay. Remnant XLS visible (K=4.0)
37 - 41	<u>Tuff</u> - Dark-gray, fairly well indurated (K=4.3)
41 - 57	<u>Tuff</u> - As 85-122
57 - 59	<u>Tuff</u> - As above except for trace of pyrite.
59 - 67	<u>Tuff</u> - As 85-122
